MicroSafe's Nanocyn® Disinfectant & Sanitiser Receives Additional TGA Approvals

MicroSafe® Care Australia, a subsidiary of the MicroSafe Group, is making waves in the biomedical science industry yet again with the Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA) approving additional claims for the Nanocyn® Disinfectant & Sanitiser.

Nanocyn® was the first all-natural disinfectant of its kind on the market in Australia that has achieved the claims against SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19) and Norovirus (Gastro), killing and eliminating them in just 30 seconds, in April 2020. In addition, the product has now also been approved against the Influenza (H1N1) virus, as well as Fungi and Mould (including Tinea and Candida Albicans), with a groundbreaking 30 seconds contact time.

Nanocyn® continues to be the leader of the fastest acting disinfectants on the market.

Matt Seifert, Managing Director for MicroSafe Care Australia, said: "We are very pleased with the new claims for Nanocyn®, which continues to go from strength to strength. Not are we only approved to kill SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19) and the much harder to kill Norovirus (Gastro) in 30 seconds, we are now also adding Influenza, Fungus and Mould to our already impressive label claims".

Mr Seifert continued: "There has been a steep learning curve across many sectors on the performance requirements of disinfectants. With no end to the pandemic in sight, it is very important to use disinfectant products as per the manufacturers' recommendations. For high-touchpoint cleaning, there is simply not enough time to wait for 3, 5 or even 10 minutes for a product to act on the surface - 30 seconds is now the standard. Adhering to contact times remains the key to using a disinfectant properly."

Nanocyn® is non-toxic, non-corrosive, made from 100% natural ingredients, is 100% biodegradable and pH-neutral. The product is entered into the TGA - ARTG as a registered, hospital-grade disinfectant with claims. The new entry also includes: The Nanocyn® Disinfectant & Sanitiser is intended for use in medical, dental, healthcare, aged care, aviation, transport, educational, public, leisure, office, food-producing and general environments, intended to be used in quarantine facilities, including hotel quarantine. The product can be applied with misting, fogging, ULV and electrostatic delivery devices.

With three Australian states currently in lockdown and millions of residents only allowed to leave their homes for government-mandated reasons, it is now more than ever imperative that community areas and workplaces are disinfected effectively to aid in stopping the spread of the SARS-CoV-2 virus as well as other viruses that are still with us like Norovirus and Influenza.

Mr Seifert added: "Our health and wellbeing is priceless, and it is important to use products that are not only highly effective but also pose no harm to people, animals and the environment. It simply makes no sense to add dangerous toxins to an environment for the purpose of killing viruses and bacteria. Companies who need to disinfect their workplaces also need to make sure that the product being used is not damaging their assets."

Nanocyn® does not contain any quaternary ammonia compounds (QUADs), alcohols, Amines or chloroacetic acid. Nanocyn® comes ready-to-use, requiring no dilution, special protection or disposal.
